


Restroom Expectations and Safety

For the safety and well-being of all students, the following restroom expectations must be followed at all times:



Safety

– Bathroom stalls are small, private spaces that are not designed for multiple occupants. Having more than one student inside a stall can lead to unsafe situations, including horseplay, accidents, or potential physical harm.

Privacy

– Every student has the right to personal privacy in the restroom. Multiple students occupying a single stall violates this expectation and creates an inappropriate environment.

Misuse of Space

– When students gather inside a stall, it raises concerns about prohibited behaviors (such as vaping, substance use, or other misconduct) that compromise a safe and healthy school environment.

Smells

– If a staff member enters the restroom and there are students present while the restroom smells like marijuana or vape smoke, the students in the restroom at that time will be sent home.

If a student enters the restroom and smells vape smoke or marijuana, they must report it to a staff member immediately. Failing to report it may result in the student being considered involved and being sent home as well.
